AN ACT Changing the Name of Pownal State School to Pineland Hospital and Training Center.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 27, § 143, amended. Section 143 of chapter 27 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 143. Management; ages of inmates. The ~~Pownal State School~~ **Pineland Hospital and Training Center**, heretofore established at Pownal in the county of Cumberland, shall be maintained for the care and education of idiotic and feeble-minded males and females, between the ages of 5 years and 55 years, except that idiotic and feeble-minded state paupers or patients transferred from either State Hospital for the insane under the provisions of this chapter may be admitted after the above stated age.'

Sec. 2. Amendatory clause. Wherever in the Revised Statutes or public laws or private and special laws, the words "Pownal State School" appear they shall be amended to words "Pineland Hospital and Training Center."
